The National Scholastic Athletics Foundation (“NSAF”) in cooperation with USA Track & Field (“USATF”) and the US Olympic Committee (“USOC”) is committed to improving the safety of athletes as well as their physical, emotional and social development and to ensuring that athletes can participate in our sport in an environment free of misconduct.

To this end, NSAF requires all those who participate in its Events either as staff, volunteers, vendors, sponsors, media, medical persons, or any others who are credentialed and who have access to athletes to refrain from all forms of misconduct, which include without limitation:

- All forms of sexual misconduct, including child sexual abuse
- Emotional misconduct
- Physical misconduct
- Bullying
- Harassment
- Hazing

In the event any of the above persons are found to have engaged in any of the forms of misconduct described above at the Event, or if there is reasonable suspicion that they have done so, their behavior will be reported to law enforcement, and they will surrender their Event credential and be removed from the Event Facility.
